



Zürs is one of the most luxurious ski resorts in Austria and has a fantastic selection of top-class hotels, spas and restaurants. The skiing is high quality too with access to 305km of pistes with a full Arlberg ski pass. The off-piste is some of the best lift-served freeride terrain in the world, perfect on powder days. The resort also prides itself on its eco-conscious initiatives, with its biomass district heating. This means the ski resort is independent of fossil fuels.

Top Runs

- There is a gentle beginner area on the edge of the village with a couple of drag lifts. Perfect for learning.
- Under the fast Hexenboden chair lift there is a long, easy blue run. Perfect for skiers progressing from the beginner area.
- At the top of the Muggengrat chairlift, there's a long, sweeping red run heading back into Zürs. A good run to pick up a bit of speed.
- Advanced skiers can test themselves by trying to complete the Run of Fame ski circuit. 85km of pistes stretching over the Arlberg ski area. One of the most legendary ski experiences you can do.



Best for Après Ski

- **Bar Vernissage**
Head to this bar for easy après ski drinks. A popular stop in the evening for a disco once the lifts have closed.
- **Sporthotel Zürsersee**
A cosy bar that's great for an after-ski pitstop. There's a good selection of local beers and delightful cocktails.
- **Krone Bar**
A fun après ski bar in the centre of Lech, directly on the slopes. Burgers, soups, Chateaubriand and other delicacies are on the menu.
- **Seekopf**
On the mountain, this is a great place to enjoy the beautiful views and have a drink on the large sun terrace.
