



La Rosière is part of the Espace San Bernardo ski area in France, and has access to 160km of pistes. You can venture over the border to Italy and enjoy the slopes of La Thuile too. The skiing is superb in both resorts with vast, diverse terrain. The village itself still has a traditional alpine feel. There's plenty of bars and restaurants to choose from, all of which have a beautiful backdrop of the Isère Valley.

Top Runs

- There are nursery slopes just above the village for beginners. Below Roc Noir, there are plenty of blue runs to progress on.
- The red Fontaine Froide piste from the summit of the Roc Noir is a great ski. It'll take you to E cudets after an exciting 1,140m descent.
- If you want a seriously steep black run, Etagne on the Mont Valaisan sector is a great challenge. Something to note: the slope has a 74% gradient.
- Another black run to try is la François Berthod. The piste is used for both the Alpine and Telemark World Cup.



Best for Après Ski

- **La Taverne du McKinley**
Head to this lively spot after a day on the slopes. It has a cosy interior, as well as a large sunny terrace for parents – perfect to keep an eye on the children sledging!
- **Le Moo Bar**
This bar has a relaxed atmosphere. A great place to have a drink or a bite to eat after a day on the slopes.
- **Le Comptoir**
Located in the middle of La Rosière, this bar is definitely the best spot to watch live sport in the resort.
- **Le Flocon**
Admire beautiful views of Mont Pourri from the foot of the slopes in Eucherts. The bar is also attached to a bowling alley.

Recommended Restaurants

- **Le Genepi**
This restaurant serves delicious duck, steak and salmon specialities. There is a great variety of dishes to choose from.
- **L'Antigel**
Located on the slopes down to La Rosière, L'Antigel is the perfect lunchtime stop. Enjoy delicious food with panoramic views.
- **L'Estam**
For delightful Savoie cuisine head to L'Estam. There's also great pizzas and burgers to enjoy too.
- **Restaurant L'Ancolie**
Enjoy this fantastic restaurant serving typical Savoyard dishes which you can enjoy from the panoramic sun terrace.
