Our View on Les Deux Alpes





Les Deux Alpes in France is best known for having Europe's largest skiable glacier, and boasts one of the world's greatest on-piste vertical drops: an exhilarating descent of 2,268m, which you can ski the whole way down. The resort also has one of the largest snowparks in the Alps, and offers a wealth of off-piste potential. It has plenty of easily-accessible beginners' slopes and lots of activities for non-skiers such as swimming, bowling and spas. This makes it a resort that is well suited to most categories of visitors and an ideal choice for mixed-ability groups. It is also renowned for its lively après ski and nightlife.

Top Runs

- Signal 3 red run up on the glacier is a fantastic wide piste, with consistently good snow all season, which is perfect for intermediates looking to crank up their speed and work on their technique.
- The top Glacier du Mont-de-Lans section has long, easy runs with wonderful views, served by an underground funicular and draglifts. From the top you can descend all the way down to Mont-de-Lans, a descent of 2,268m – the world's biggest on-piste vertical.
- For beginners, the nursery slopes beside the village are spacious and gentle and there are five free lifts. The glacier also has a nice variety of long, easy slopes.
- La Valentine black run has a vertical drop of 300m, making it one of the fastest pistes Les Deux Alpes has to offer. It is very steep, very wide and the best time to ski it is in the early morning when the piste is deserted.

Bar Motown Café
 Motown offers a wide choice

- Smithy's Tavern
 Known for its après-ski
 parties, expect themed nights
 with live bands and DJs
 throughout the winter. There
 is also a chargrilled restaurant
 upstairs.
- Pano Bar
 Located on the mountain at 2,600m, opposite Jandri Express mid-station. Half-price beers in the afternoon and live DJ sets. This is a great place to watch the sun go down after skiing.
