Our View on Courmayeur





Courmayeur is located in the Aosta Valley, Northern Italy, at the foot of Mont Blanc. This is an ideal place to spend the weekend. Mont Blanc is the highest mountain in Western Europe and has fabulous runs for all levels of skiers and boarders, although the fun terrain is best suited to intermediates. Courmayeur is a charming, car-free village that offers stunning views of the infamous Mont Blanc. With long runs between 1,700m – 2,250m, it is no surprise that many travel from far away to enjoy those fresh, sunny powder days.

Top Runs

- Plan Chécrouit is great for the morning sun. You can take the Youla cable car to the top of Courmayeur's pisted runs and then take a smaller cable car to Crest D'Arpe.
- For intermediates, there are a few long runs. There is a 700m vertical from Chécrouit to Zerotta, and a 1,400m vertical from Cresta Youla.
- For beginners, there are a few short blue runs and a free lift on a beginner slope at Plan Chécrouit. However, the best place to start is the top of Entreves, which is a beginner slope with a magic carpet.
- The considerable off-piste potential of the area is the main attraction. There are three outstanding areas - Dolonne, the Val Veny beneath Mont Blanc, and the village of La Balme.

• Super G

Super G is a venue located on the slopes at Plan Checrouit offering fantastic on-slope après ski parties, with national and international DJs and daylight shows, Super G offers a lively après ski experience.
